Teams are made up by having the men who have said they would skip getting together with the list of players who have signed up for the other positions and having a draft. These teams play until Christmas when the draft is done again. These new teams then play together for the rest of the season, with a new schedule.

This is a fun league, scores are kept but standings are not broadcast.

Most players stay for a \$.50 cent coffee after play.
